"Who Am I?"

"Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ; (Eph. 3:8).

In meditating just recently on the Lord, and the grace He has given me in Christ, I was made to ask the question: Who am I? Who am I that the King should bleed and die for? Who am I that the Lord should leave all his glory in Heaven and come and die as my substitute? Yes, who am I?

I am less than the least of the saints. Just to think that the Lord would look down from His throne in Heaven, and say to the blessed Holy Spirit; he is my elect, give him the Effectual Call, call him by name. Show him his dead condition (Eph. 2:1). Reprove him of sin, righteousness and judgment (Jn. 16:7-11).

Who am I, that the Holy Spirit would so tenderly deal with my heart? In spite of all my waywardness and being such a hardheaded sinner as I was, yet He had mercy on me and saved such a hell-deserving sinner as I. Who am I, that he would bestow such grace on?

It means something to be saved. The greatest thing in all this world is just to know the Lord Jesus Christ as your Lord and your Saviour. I'm not talking about "joining" the church and being religious. Before the Lord awakened me to my lost condition, I was just as religious as could

And I hope these messages are skinning the bark off your old rhinoceros hide and tormenting you day and night.

It's the greatest thing in all the universe just to know Christ. Do YOU know Christ? Not the other fellow just YOU. I had a letter just recently from a soul I occasionally hear from. My heart went out to her. Oh may the Lord bring you down in repentance and reveal Christ to your heart is my prayer.
