



To Detect

On Heart Attack

Do you know what a neart attack is? A stroke?

Could you recognize the warning signs and know what to do if you or someone near you were having a heart attack or a stroke?

The answers to these questions are given in a booklet which is available without charge from the American Heart Association, Charlotte-Mecklenburg Chapter, 1351 East Morehead Street, Charlotte, 28204. Ask for Fact Sheet on Heart Attack, Stroke, and Risk Factors." Please include a stamped, self addressed long envelope.

The booklet also states that there are several ways to improve your chances of avoiding a heart attack or a stroke. It advises having your blood pressure checked at least once a year, because high blood pressure is a major risk factor in heart attack and is the major risk factor in With your doctor's stroke. help, you can lower your blood pressure to safe limits. Regular medical checkups are advisable to spot trouble early in all areas of health.

Additional advice given in the booklet is to eat a wellbalanced diet low in cholesterol and animal fats and to limit calories if overweight; don't smoke cigarettes, because smoking increases the risk of heart attack; and to exercise regularly and sensibly



so, you may end up with shrubs unsuited to the site because of their potential to grow into over-sized plants.

North Carolina Agricultural **Extension Service specialists** suggest that the wise homeowner will select shrubs that, by nature, are low growing and slow growing.

Among the most popular of the low-growing evergreens are the Japanese hollies. They grow from one to four feet high. Hellers and Stokes Japanese hollies are particularly popular with owners of low ranch-style homes. They grow low to the ground, making a handsome mound of greenery

Another low growing shrub is dwarf yaupon, which is often mistaken for Hellers

can bring insect pests into your home on firewood, say NCSU agricultural extension specialists.

For example, ants may be under the bark of wood and become active when the wood is placed in a warm area. Cockroaches may also enter your home on damp or partial-

ly decayed wood. Always inspect firewood carefully and remove any insects before moving the wood indoors, recommend the specialists.
