Black Women's

Workshop To

Attack Racism

Black women in America face two barriers: racism and sexism. Changing this situation will be the theme of a speical Workshop on Sat. Feb. 10 at the Holiday Inn, 3815 N. Tryon.

Called "WEETAP" Women's Educational Equity Training and Assessment Project" - the workshop will focus on awareness understanding and skill development of black women for positive social change.

A recent Carnegie Corpora, tion study showed that "Occupational segregation by sex was exactly as great today as it was at the turn of the Century, if not worse.'

According to workshop coordinator Dr. Bertha Maxwell "The workshop is aimed at promoting black women's awareness of recent equity and sex discrimination legislation and also to help develop skills and understanding to attack racism and sex-

ism in our communities."
The workshop is sponsored by the Charlotte Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority which received a grant from the Office of Education. This is one of 7 regional workshops being held around the country.

Registration begins at 9 a.m., followed by opening remarks from Dr. Delores
Thomas, WEETAP director in Washington, D.C. Dr. Maxwell will present a multi-media show, "The Building of Institutional Racism."

Luncheon panelists will be attorney Julius Chambers and Harris Williams of the Equal **Employment Opportunity** Commission.

In the afternoon training and power strategies sessions will be held focusing on developing action plans.

"We're hoping participants will go back to their groups and set up some programs," said Maxwell. "Many women are tired of the same old stuff. They're no longer going to participate in the 'go fix the coffee, girl' mentality."
