If you enjoy Charlotte's Carowinds here's an opportunity to visit an even larger amusement park; Kings Dominion near Richmond, Virginia.

The McCrory Branch YMCA is sponsoring a trip to the amusement park and a tour of Washington, D.C. the weekend of July 20-22.

An \$80 fee per person will include all bus transportation, Saturday admission to Kings Dominion and an all-day sight-seeing tour of Washington, D.C. on Sunday.

The fee is based on four people per room, with slightly higher rates for fewer people per room.

Mercy Hospital Opens

Infertility Counseling

One out of every six couples in Charlotte faces problems of infertility. That fact alone was enough to make Mercy Hospital want to help by cooperating with Catholic Social Services to house an Infertility Counseling Service.

Mrs. Barbara Fields, an RN who has studied and specializes in counseling couples about infertility, began seeing clients last week in her office located on the first floor of the hospital. "Here is a chance," she said, "for Mercy Hospital to offer something in the way of new life."

Hospital president Sister Mary Jerome agrees. "We are very enthusiastic about housing this service because it gives Mercy, which no longer has an obstetrics department, a unique role in helping to bring about new life."

Another plus in the link between the hospital and the counseling service is the hormone testing for infertility offered in the Laboratory. Mercy is the only local hospital doing these tests. "Before we had to send away to Chapel Hill, Duke, or California," explains Mrs. Fields. Such tests are vital because, she states, 95 percent of infertility problems have a physical cause.

Mrs. Fields became aware of the need for infertility counseling while teaching a course in natural family planning, seeing the many couples who kept returning to the classes, desiring to achieve a pregnancy. In cooperation with CPCC, she helped set up a course to teach couples about infertility. "The key is education," she says, "understanding infertility and knowing what questions to ask. This is
