## Oratorio Singers

### To Present

### Final Concert

Was it for Mom or the Little Woman?

That's part of the mystery surrounding Mozart's "Grand Mass in C Minor," monumental work by the Oratorio Singers of Charlotte as the second and final concert of their 28th season.

The program will be at 8 p.m. Saturday, May 5, in Owens Auditorium.

Guest soloists include Carole Bogard, soprano; Brenda Boozer, mezzo-soprano; Walter Carringer, tenor; and Bruce Schoonmaker, bass.

Musicologists are not sure what inspired Mozart in creating this 18th century mass. Some suggest it was dedicated to his bride. Others say some passages indicate the Mass memorialized his dead mother.

Mozart never completed the original manuscript. Ultimately, he filled it out by including his "Cantata Davidde Penitente." Nevertheless, the Mass is termed "a great and deeply felt work for the church."

The 160-voice chorus is in final rehearsals for this demanding concert. Oratorio Singers are residents of Mecklenburg County and the surrounding area.

The four guest soloists are career singers.

So you think ABC's "Salvage-1" is silly. Well, listen to this. "When Harry Broderick (Andy Griffith) of 'Salvage-1' decided to build a homemade rocket ship and launch it, destination moon, his dream wasn't too far from reality," says a NASA spokesman at the Ames Research Center in North Carolina.

The truth of the matter is that there are a number of imaginative and inventive people who share Broderick's quest to conquer the seemingly impossible. Robert Truex of Los Altos, Calif., first became a national figure when he designed and built the rocket-propelled motorcycle that was used by famed daredevil Evel Knievel.
