## Natalie Cole Comments On Her Broken Marriage

Singer Natalie Cole commented on her broken marriage to Marvin Yancey, her co-producer and writer during a Washington, D.C. interview. "Marvin is a real musician, like my father. He used to play on the window sills because he didn't have a piano. He's a genius. I gave something to him, he to me. It would be a shame to break up a successful musical partnership, but it's just something we are still working on."




