Soul Train To Present Sounds Of Third World

The imaginative, yet polished, reggae sounds of Third World, and the lush vocalizing of Mr. Danny Pearson, singer-songwriter, add up to a pleasurable interlude on Don Cornelius' Soul Train this weekend.

Third World leads off with their recent success, "Now That We Found Love," described as "an absolutely stunning fusion of disco and reggae," followed by "African Woman." Both tunes are on their latest LP, "Journey To Addis."

The six-piece ensemble, all Jamaicans, draws its musical inspiration from black African, American and Jamaican styles which, with added musical textures and instruments never before heard in reggae, brings a new dimension to Western music. Mr. Danny Pearson, whose wide ranging tenor shows up to full advantage on "What's Your Sign Girl" and "Honey, Please," is a protege of Maestro Barry White who produced his solo album, "Barry White Presents Mr. Danny Pearson."

Permanent Third Molars

Wisdom teeth, when impacted or infected, are notoriously painful...so much so that many people believe they should be extracted BEFORE there is any sign of trouble or discomfort, rather than waiting. This thinking may make sense in some circles, but such action does not take into consideration nature's intention for the efficient service-function of these permanent third molars.

Because of their positioning - far back in the jaw - wisdom teeth are considerably more difficult to clean. To do a careful, proper job takes more time and care than cleaning other teeth, so in the rush-rush of our culture these teeth are frequently neglected. Such lack of care frequently leads to a more rapid rate of decay when compared with other more accessible teeth.

"Wisdom teeth" (so named because they erupt around the age one reaches 18-21 years of age) in the mouths of people with small jaws are quite often badly formed, due to being crowded into insufficient spacing. But, people with large jaws and small teeth do not generally have this difficulty and enjoy the use of normal, healthy wisdom teeth.

Aside from providing broader food-chewing capabilities and adding to the shaping of the face, wisdom teeth can be called upon later in life to serve as an anchor for a fixed bridge (non-removable partial denture) which would probably not be possible to wear without the wisdom teeth being there; a removable partial is the alternative, but

seldom do these equal the functional efficiency of the fixed bridge.

Thus, it becomes apparent that careful attention to hygiene for the wisdom teeth, just as with teeth that are

more advantageously situated, is well worth the added time and effort that it takes.

Don't let anyone scare you into thinking -- with horror stories of pain and anguish that were caused by infected-impacted wisdom teeth -- that yours should be removed well in advance of any such possibilities. Wisdom teeth are not a curse, but really a blessing... if you take care of them!
