Sykes is deputy secretary of the Maryland Department of Human Resources. He was born December 5, 1926, in Halifax, Virginia. He received a B.S. from Hampton Institute in 1956 and an M.S.W. from Howard University in 1962. He served in the U.S. Army from 1956 to 1957.

From 1957 to 1960 Sykes was a caseworker for the City of Baltimore, and from 1960 to 1961 he was a probation officer for the Criminal Division of the Supreme Bench of Baltimore. From 1961 to 1964 he was a school social worker for the Baltimore City Department of Education.
