Nigerian Rev. Victor Muso Will Be Calvary's Guest Speaker

Rev. Muso is now studying at Columbia Bible College Graduate School located in South Carolina. He is a native of Nigeria and holds various positions with evangelistic groups of Africa.

He is the General Secretary of Evangelism for Churches of West Africa, the head of the Department of Church Growth of the Evangelical Churches of West Africa, Trustee of the Mennonite Central Committee, and Honorary Secretary of the Nigeria Bible Translation Trust. He is also a graduate of Nigeria Igbaji Cemetery.

Rev. Muso's wife and four children joined him in the United States last year. They will be present at Calvary Church also.
