13th Bond Film Scheduled For 1982

"Octopussy" is the next James Bond 007 adventure to be filmed, it was jointly announced here today by producer Albert R. Broccoli and Steven Bach, Senior Vice President-Worldwide Production for United Artists Corporation.

"Octopussy", by Ian Fleming, first appeared in print in the London Daily Express in England, and in "Playboy" magazine in the United States.

Choice of locations and other pre-production activities will be

set toward the end of this year utilizing the "For Your Eyes Only" production team under executive producer Michael G. Wilson. The start date for principal photography is being slotted for early 1982, with the initial release for Christmas that year.

Broccoli further announced that "Octopussy", the 13th in the highly successful series, will be filmed at Pinewood Studios, and like all previous 12 James Bond films, it will be released by United Artists, a Transamerica Company.

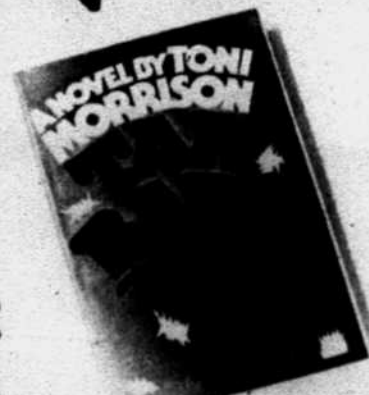
