United Nations Delegation To Join "King Week" Celebration

ATLANTA - High-ranking diplomats from the United Nations have accepted the invitation of Atlanta's Martin Luther King Jr. Center for Nonviolent Social Change to participate in King Week 1982, the annual observance of the slain civil rights leader's birthday.

"This will be the second time the King Center has been honored to host a United Nation's delegation," said Mrs. Coretta Scott King, President of the King Center in announcing the U.N. visit. "We are indeed fortunate to have such distinguished international representation join us for our celebration and the historic dedication of the Freedom Hall Complex."

The delegation, headed by Nigerian Ambassador to the United Nations and Chairman of the U.N. Special Committee Against Apartheid Alhaji Yusuff Maitama-Sule, will arrive on January 12 to take part in various King Week events, including the January 15 Freedom Hall Complex Dedication ceremony. Other members of the U.N. delegation include Indian Ambassador Natarajan Krishnan; Ukranian Ambassador Vladmir Alekseyevich Kravets; Somalian Ambassador Ahmed Mohamed Adan; Trinadad and Tobago Ambassador Frank Owen; E. S. Reddy, Director of the U.N. Centre Against Apartheid; and Ibrahim Noor, Secretary of the Special Committee Against Apartheid.

In addition to the Freedom Hall Complex Dedication, the U.N. delegation will participate in two seminars on January 13 and 14, sponsored by the King Center's Institute On International Affairs. The first seminar, "Countering the Retreat from Universal Human Rights," will be held from 2-5 p.m. on January 13. The second, "South Africa-Time Running Out," is scheduled for 2-5 p.m. on January

A press conference for the delegation has been scheduled for 12:30 p.m. on January 13 at Freedom Hall. That same evening at 7 p.m. the diplomats will be honored at the Center's President's Reception at the Peachtree Center Plaza Hotel.
