The Investment Institute provides the following example to illustrate the financial potential of an IRA investment:

If you put your IRA money into an investment paying a 12 percent rate of return, and you were able to contribute a \$250 a year. after 10 years you would If you let your IRA grow for 20 years, you'd have \$20,175 in your account. And if you have a long time before your retirement, perhaps 30 years, the amount would climb to \$67,573."
