A. D. Davis, Vice Chairman of the Sunbelt's largest food retailer, said overall sales during the quarter ended September 22, 1982 amounted to \$1,582,824,000 compared with \$1,465,356,000 during

the same period last year, a gain of \$117,468,000 or 8.0 percent earnings per share were 84 cents vs. 77 cents, while total earnings increased to \$20,773,000 from \$19,133,000 achieved during the comparable period last

Commenting on first quarter results, Mr. Davis said, "Although our new store program has slowed down due to tight money we have aggressively enlarged and remodeled proven store locations to increase sales per square foot in our retail store facilities. Of 1,228 stores, 953 have been enlarged or remodeled in the past seven years.
