

Proposals will be received until 3:00 P.M. on September 9, 1983, for the use of funds provided by the City of Charlotte for 6 percent loans to be used for construction or expansion projects which will result in the immediate establishment of jobs for low and moderate income persons from the City of Charlotte.

The preferred projects will be industrial or commercial developments, which can begin expansion activities or start construction by October 31. 1983, and which must, in the case of construction projects, be 100 percent completed by April 30, 1984. 
