Ross To Recruit Minority Students

Margaret Ross is confident that her 15 years of experience in human services have prepared her well to become CPCC's first recruiter of minority students.

A Charlotte native, she's worked for the Westchester County, N.Y. Department of Social Services, the City of Charlotte's Em-ployment and Training Office, CPCC's High School Completion Program, and the project CPCC operates with the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools to encourage drop-outs to complete high school.

Now she's ready to visit meetings of predominantly black groups and college recruiting days at high schools to let folks know about opportunities at CPCC.

"While my emphasis is on blacks, I'm ready to help any student interested in attending college here," says Margaret, who

began her new job May 3.
"I'll be recruiting students to all programs but concentrating on college transfer (liberal arts), nursing, allied health (respiratory and physical therapy), and sich technical areas as engineering and computer science," Margaret says. "In all instances, I'm seeking the highly motivated person looking for a challenging and rewarding career."

Margaret says CPCC's open door admissions policy, affordable tuition and quality education provide her with major selling points.

"Many people don't realize that we take a student on whatever academic level he is functioning and helim continue through the highest levels of education," she says. "I really feel great when I can watch a person grow and feel I played a small part in it."
