## UNCF Is \$250,000 Better Off

Special To The Post... Chicago, IL - The United Negro College Fund is \$250,000 better off from a corporate donation it received Sunday - 16 cubic feet of hard cash.

Delivered by armored car, the gift to the Fund was paid in one-dollar bills at the Ebony Fashion Fair in Chicago's McCormick Place auditorium. If stacked, the money would reach almost 125 feet in the air, or about the height of a 10-story building.

According to Bass, Reynolds Industries chose to present its 1983 contribution to the United Negro College Fund in this unusual manner to encourage others to support historically black colleges and universities. The cash donation is the first payment made by Reynolds Industries on its \$1 million commitment to the Fund announced in June.

An audience of 4,000 watched as armed guards wheeled onto the stage a box the size of a refrigerator, covered in black velvet and holding the money. "Perhaps you would be willing to accept cash?"

"I have to admit that this is the largest number of one-dollar bills I have ever seen in one place at one time," said Christopher F. Edley, president and chief executive officer of the United Negro College Fund. "RJR unquestionably provides outstanding leadership when it comes to support of higher education," Edley said. "Students on our college campuses will certainly benefit from the company's generous gift," he stated.

The United Negro College Fund campaign goal for 1983 is \$28 million.
