The company's added service of directly supplying the customer, only two years old, shows all the signs of becoming a hotly demanded alternative to purchasing records.

That's where the local firm of Global Records comes in. "What we do is put together a record certificate book which costs \$10 or \$30. In the \$10 book,

there are 10 certificates and in the \$30 book, there are 30 certificates," pointed out Pressley.

"When you buy a record from us at the national list price you can then get another record with just a certificate. You pick your selections from a sample catalog that you receive when you purchase a cer-tificate book from us and place it on the order

Pressley was quick to note that a customer's selection is not limited to what's available on the catalogs. "As long as a record is still in production, it doesn't matter if it's listed or not, we can get it," assured Pressley. This enormity of Global's selections also includes types of music, such as, pop, rock, country, soul, jazz, gospel, new wave, blues,

Unlike a record club, at Global there are no contracts where you have to buy a certain amount of records within a specific time. "As long as you have our certificates, we'll honor them.'

That statement indicates that Global Records plans to be around for quite

while. Pressley confirmed that remark: "We did a lot of testing before we came here and we plan to stay. There were other areas that we were considering aside from Charlotte, but our results showed that Charlotte buys a lot of masic '

In the near future, Global Records plans to eliminate the two to four week wait customers now face before receiving their music by storing records ourselves. "If Charlotte proves to be the market we expect it to be, then it (Charlotte) could become the first record warehouse on the East Coast."




