**Black Group  
Raise \$6,000  
For Eddie Knox**

More than 500 members of Charlotte's black political community gathered recently to show their strong support for Democratic gubernatorial candidate Eddie Knox at a special fundraiser.

The February 15 fundraiser was co-hosted by Charlotte Mayor Harvey Gantt and Bob Walton, vice chairman of the Mecklenburg County Commissioners.

"We saw the event as a means of recognizing the support of Eddie has given to the black community in Charlotte and Mecklenburg County as well as a way to acknowledge and encourage statewide support from blacks for Eddie's campaign," Gantt said. "Eddie has a great deal of strength with blacks across the state and we wanted to keep the momentum going."

The reception was part of a fundraising effort by the Committee of 100, a group of 100 black Charlotteans who are working to elect Knox as governor.

"The Committee of 100 wants to show that blacks in Charlotte-Mecklenburg are supporting a candidate whom we feel is an extraordinarily well-qualified public servant," said Walton. "We also want to raise \$10,000 for Eddie Knox and are optimistic we'll reach that goal. With the February reception, we have brought in \$8,000 and still have other projects planned before the May 8 primary."

ABLE is the first project in the nation to use the latest in educational technology - microcomputers, television, sound-slide programs and more - to teach illiterate adults. Instruction is free.
