

# CPCC Classes At Double Oaks Begin Monday, April 2

Central Piedmont Community College classes at Double Oaks Community Service Center will begin the Spring Quarter April 2. Registration for all classes will be held April 2-5.

Morning, afternoon and evening classes will be offered at the CPCC site located off Double Oaks Rd. on Eureka St. You will be able to double your earning power through the following classes at Double Oaks: High School Completion; Adult Basic Education; Job Preparation and Small Business.

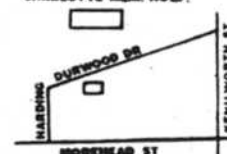
