Neill, Johnson To Head Little Rock Project

Charlotte, N.C. - Rolfe Neill, president and publisher of The Charlotte Observer, and Sam Johnson, owner of Sam Johnson Lincoln-Mercury in Charlotte, have been named to head the Little Rock Restoration Project.

The Little Rock Restoration Project is a campaign to raise \$800,000 to complete the rehabilitation of the historic Little Rock AME Zion Church to house the Afro-American Cultural Center. The fundraising effort will be conducted during the months of May and June. A formal announcement of campaign details will be made at special news conference at noon, Friday, May 4, at the site of the old church on the corner of East Seventh and North Myers Streets in the First Ward community of Uptown Charlotte.

"The restoration of the old Little Rock church means a lot to the history of Charlotte because of the rich history of the church itself," says Neill. "I am proud to serve as chairman of this very important community project," he adds.

"The church is a symbol of pride for all of Charlotte," notes Johnson, the vice chairman.

Adult Bus Drivers Needed

The upswing in the economy is good news for most of us. But it's causing some real problems for CMS transportation specialists who are losing many adult bus drivers to higher paying, full-time jobs in private industry.

Adult drivers, who are hot classroom aides, generally work about four hours a day. When jobs were scarce during the recession, that four hours of work was very attractive to many people, and the school system easily recruited all the adult drivers it needed. But that has changed dramatically during the 1983-84 school year.

For example, Don Wright, South Mecklenburg's transportation specialist, has lost 22 adult drivers this year and needs to recruit 12 immediately just to complete this school year. "One person might get a job and find out there are three or four vacancies in that company, and he's coming back and telling other drivers," says Wright.

Wright says many of the drivers he has lost have taken jobs paying \$6.50 to \$10 an hour. Beginning pay for bus drivers is \$3.87.
