Rev. Davis and his family moved to Charlotte in October, 1980, from Chicago, and he began a Radio Ministry on WQQC which lasted two years, but had to be tabled because there was so much work to be done in building the congregation of the church.

Rev. Davis is a graduate of Xavier University of Cincinnati, Ohio... Moody Bible Institute of Chicago, and he has studied at Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary in San Francisco. He is a member of the Charlotte Minister's Conference No. 2, and the Mecklenburg Baptist Pastor's Conference.

One of the most encouraging things about Rev. Davis is his great concern for people. He is a person who can sit down and negotiate with the business executive and who can sit down and counsel the poor and needy. Rev. Davis believes that people of all races and backgrounds must come together to

help eliminate the injustices and the poverty that is so evident in our society. Galilean Baptist, under the leadership of Pastor Davis, has established a Food Bank and a Clothing Closet. During the Christmas holidays and through the first part of this year, Galilean Baptist has assisted well over 60 families with food, clothes, furniture or other physical needs. Rev. Davis is hoping to establish a coalition of white and black churches in an effort to find employment for the people in the city, especially young black men.

Rev. Davis enjoys "meeting people where they are in life and then leading and guiding them to where Jesus wants them to be."

Registration for summer camp offered by the YWCA is now underway. Not All Eye Care Practitioners Have Same Training

To a lot of people, any health care practitioner who works with the eyes is an "eye doctor." The North Carolina Medical Society notes that not all eye care practitioners have the same thing or offer the same scope of services.

An ophthalmologist is a doctor of medicine (M.D.) who specializes in the care of the eye and all its related structures. The ophthalmologist uses a comprehensive examination of the eyes to diagnose eye diseases and defects, and signs of possible

diseases elsewhere in the body. The ophthalmologist prescribes whatever eye treatment necessary, including prescribing of eye-glasses, fitting of contact

lenses and optical aids, prescribing of medication and/or surgery when needed and performs eye surgery when required.

An optometrist is a person specifically trained, educated, and state licensed to examine the eyes and related structures to detect the presence of vision problems. The optometrist fits corrective lenses.

The optician is a person trained in the science, craft, and art of optics, as applied to the interpretation of the ophthalmologist's or the optometrist's prescriptions and to making the proper lenses or accessories.

All of these providers offer eye care, but only the ophthalmologist is a licensed medical doctor.
