

Eddie Knox Believes: Bed Space Requirement For The Elderly To Triple

Raleigh - "In-home care offers the most viable alternative in meeting our future needs for nursing home and rest home

space," said Eddie Knox, Democratic candidate for governor, at a meeting of the National Association of Retired Federal Employ-

ees Thursday. Knox pointed out that North Carolina's bed space requirements for the elderly is expected to triple by 1995.

"We have to ensure that members of our senior population receive the care they need, but at the same time be aware that money

is also a problem," Knox said. "In-home care helps solve space and financial needs. More importantly, in-home care allows more

of our senior people to remain in their own homes." Knox said he never realized why his 62 year old

mother was so adamant about staying in her own home until he began his campaign for governor.
