CPCC Receives \$32,589 Grant

Central Piedmont Community College has received a \$32,589 grant to expand the offerings of its Small Business Center.

The money will be used primarily to develop and offer new classes, workshops and seminars for small business in this area, according to Dr. Lois Dixon, head of the Business Administration Department at CPCC.

"So many people have wonderful business ideas and are excellent in their field of interest," Dr. Dixon said. "But they lack the management and record-keeping know-how to make their ventures successful."

"Lack of management skills is the primary reason that businesses fail."

Part of the grant money will be used to develop a brochure describing the Center's services, to purchase a microcomputer to increase the operating efficiency of the Center, and to add two temporary part-time employees at the Center.

The Center was established to provide training, counseling and support for those who want to start a small business or those who already operate a small business.

The Small Business Center works in conjunction with the Charlotte Chamber of Commerce and the Small Business Administration, a federal agency that provides financial and educational support to small business.

The grant is one of eight awarded to community colleges by the state's Department of Community Colleges.
