Enrichment Project Seeks Students

Livingstone College has scheduled a four week Summer Enrichment Project June 24 through July 20 to provide opportunities for talented and gifted high school students to expand their educational horizons.

According to Dr. Carol L. Meeks, Project Director, "The program has a three pronged focus: cultural awareness, career awareness and computer training." She continued, "It is designed for advanced achievers at the high school level to enhance their skills in composition, literature, music, computer training, physical conditioning and life skills."

During the sessions, workshops and seminars featuring prominent personalities and consultants are planned with special emphasis on career awareness and media exposure.

Dr. Meeks stressed, "Because of the residential nature of the program, we feel that it will serve to enrich students culturally, intellectually and spiritually while providing a broad based opportunity to interact meaningfully with persons of different backgrounds and cultures."

There is a cost of \$500.00 for the program which will include a student's tuition, room and board.

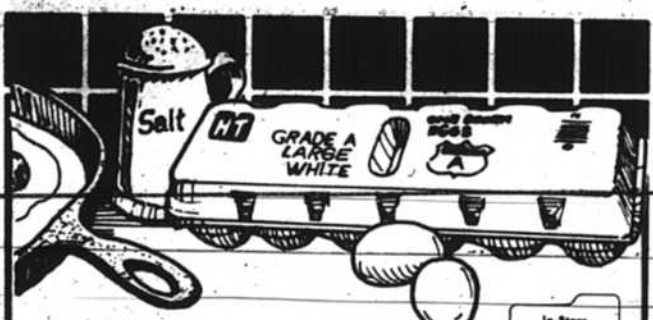
