PROGRAM OF PROJECTS

Under Section 9 of The Surface Transportation Assistance Act of 1982, approximately \$3,000,000 will be allocated to the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Urbanized Area for FY 1985. A 1984 carry-over brings the total Federal funds available to approximately \$4,088,753.
