## Church Workers To Benefit From Divinity School Meet

The Shaw Divinity School's Annual Church Leaders Conference, comprised of the Forty-Eighth Annual Ministers' Institute and the Tenth Annual Church Lay Leaders' Institute, will be held at Shaw University, Raleigh, June 11-15.

Registration for the Conference will begin at 9 a.m. on Monday, June 11. The first session is at 1:30 p.m., June 11. The conference will end near noon on Friday, June 15. Registration and all sessions of the conference will be held in the Student Union Building on the Shaw University campus. The theme for 1984 is "Biblical Images of the Church and their Contemporary Significance."

Dr. Miles J. Jones, pastor of Providence Baptist Church, Richmond, will be the principal resource person. Dr. Jones will preach the opening sermon on Monday, at 8 p.m. He will deliver a daily lecture on the theme from Tuesday through Thursday, June 12-14, at 10:30 a.m.

"Churches throughout North Carolina and the nation can benefit from the conference," said Dr. J. Z. Alexander, dean of continuing education with the Shaw Divinity School.

The conference will include programs for ministers and lay leaders - Christian education, Vacation Bible School teachers, Sunday School teach-

ers, missionaries, laymen's league members and ushers.

"The conference is designed to help these people be more effective at what they are doing," Alexander said.

Dr. Jones is a product of the public schools of Brooklyn. He also attended the College of the City of New York. He received his BA degree from Virginia Union University, Richmond, VA, his Master of Divinity degree from the School of Theology at Virginia Union University, and a Master of Arts from the Presbyterian School of Christian Education, Richmond. The University of Richmond conferred upon him the honorary Doctor of Divinity degree.

In addition to the pastorate of Providence Park, Dr. Jones is instructor of homiletics in the School of Theology, Virginia Union University, and president of the Baptist Ministers Conference of Richmond and the vicinity. He has served as moderator of the Tuckahoe Baptist Association of Virginia, as university pastor, Virginia Union University, as dean of the School of Theology, Virginia Union, and as chairman and member of the Richmond school board.

Classes for ministers and church lay leaders will be offered in "The Church Missions"; "Christian

Education and Church Training"; and "The Lay Program of the Church." A special focus on the church usher will be featured on Wednesday, June 13. Instructors during the five-day event include: Dr. Leo Williams, director of Christian education, General Baptist State Convention of North Carolina; Dr. J. B. McLester, professional guidance counselor; and Mr. Arthur Williams, past president of the State Usher Convention.

"Dr. Jones, the principal resource person, was also conference preacher during (the annual Shaw Divinity School) Pastor's Conference," which was held several months ago, Alexander said.

The cost of the full conference is \$93.15.
