Ministry Degree**

Rev. Lloyd Belton Morris, pastor of Grier Heights Presbyterian Church, received the Doctor of Ministry degree from the McCormick Theological Seminary in Chicago Ill. during the school's 150th commencement exercises.

This three year program is intended to assist pastors and church officers in developing vital and effective congregations. The McCormick Faculty teaches three-week intensive courses within a geographical area near the student's ministry. Dr. Morris was able to study at a regional center near Charlotte and still pastor his church.

All courses in the program focus on ways to improve the practice of ministry by developing the student's competency in the areas of worship, preaching, counseling, teaching and administration.

Requirements for graduation include the completion of 36 course hours and a thesis. Dr. Morris' subject was "Demonstrating Love in Congregational Life."

Commencement was held at the Rockefeller Chapel on the campus of the University of Chicago. The speaker was Dr. James Wall, editor of the "Christian Century" magazine.

Dr. Morris continued to serve his congregation at Grier Heights Presbyterian Church located at 325 Skyland Ave. while he studied short-term intensive courses at regular intervals.

Married to the former Nancy Springs of Charlotte the couple are the proud parents of two daughters, Kesten Levett and Karen Lucia.
