Central Carolina Legal Services, Inc. (CCLS) seeks a staff attorney for its main office in Greensboro.

CCLS is a nonprofit legal services program that operates within the confederation of Legal Services of North Carolina. The main office provides legal services in civil matters for low-income residents of Guilford, Montgomery, Randolph and Rockingham Counties. CCLS has a branch office in Lexington which serves Davidson and Rowan Counties.

RESPONSIBILITIES: The staff attorney will work under the supervision of an experienced attorney. He/she will be responsible for handling a regular caseload, co-counseling with other attorneys, assisting in the developing and implementing of community education efforts, working with private attorneys through bar groups and CCLS' Private Bar Involvement Projects, and assisting in the on-going legal efforts of CCLS.

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants must be (a) licensed to practice law in North Carolina or eligible for admission by comity; and (b) sensitive to the needs and concerns of low-income persons and possess the ability to relate to persons of all educational and economic backgrounds.
