Groove" typify the essence of their latest album release, "Lady."

However, when you flip the album cover over there's enough uptempo and lively dance music that could bring out the beast in anyone.

Side one consists of: "Lady You Are," "I'll Make It Up To You," "If Only You Knew," and "Don't Stop."

On side two there's: "Mr. Groove," "Smile," "Dynamite," and "Can't Get Enough of Your Love."

Johnny Mathis
"A Special Part of Me"
Either Johnny Mathis has revamped his style or I'm getting older. Personally, I rather believe the former statement. But whatever the case may be.

Mathis' latest album deserves a lot of credit for being an excellent piece of music.

His luring ballads like "The Best Is Yet To Come" and "One Love" show off what I feel may have been a hidden broader audience appeal that Mathis seems to possess.
