

WDAV Charlotte Symphony Broadcast Season Begins

WDAV (89.9 FM) will again broadcast a series of concerts by the Charlotte Symphony Orchestra and music director Leo Drei huys beginning Thursday, September 6, at 8 p.m. The 11-week series is taken from concerts recorded by WDAV during the Orchestra's 1983-84 season.

Guest artists highlighted in this year's broadcast season include pianist John Browning, violinist Ani Kafavian, trumpeter Martin Berinbaum, saxophonist James Houlik, violinist Edith Peinemann and Davidson pianist James Swisher. The season also includes the world premiere of Robert Ward's Concerto for Saxophone and Orchestra and the challenging Concerto for Orchestra by Witold Lutoslawski.

"WDAV is again pleased

to be able to broaden the audience of this talented musical organization," said station manager John Clark. "The Charlotte Symphony is so important to the cultural life of our region, and I'm delighted that WDAV can help to enhance that contribution through these broadcasts," Clark added. Production director Julie Rogier will serve as producer and host of this year's series.

WDAV will also air previews of the 1984-85 Charlotte Symphony concerts. Host Anne Wright will be joined by Dr. George Stegner for these programs to be broadcast at 6 p.m. on the Sundays prior to either the Wednesday or Saturday concerts. The first program will air Sunday, September 16.
