

A study by the Voter Education Project (VEP) revealed "while the average for all members of the House of Representatives was below the minimum standard of responsiveness set by the study, the average for Southern representatives was even

Entitled "The Responsiveness of Southern Congressional Representatives to Black Concerns," the study was conducted by Dr. Brian Sherman, VEP Research Director, and K. Farouk Brimah, VEP Assistant Research Direc-

They rated the current 116 representatives from the 11 Southern states on a Black Concerns Scale. The

scale is based upon how the representatives voted on bills of particular importance to blacks.
