Should Smoking Regulations Be Changed?

Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Jay Robinson, recently presented proposed changes in the smoking regulations at the high schools to the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education. The current policy is that each school can designate areas where smoking is allowed, and students who smoke must have parental permission slips on file in the office.

Under the proposed changes, smoking would be gradually phased out. The first year, juniors and seniors who are at least 17 and have parental permission would be issued a card and be allowed to smoke in designated areas. The following year, only seniors would be allowed to smoke. The third year, no student smoking would be permitted.

Post reporter Audrey Lodato recently went to West Charlotte High School to find out how students there felt about the proposed changes. Here's what they had to say.

●LARA SMILEY, a tenth grader who lives on Crestland Avenue, responded, "I don't think people should smoke in school. Some people don't like it. Smoking in school is inconsiderate toward other people."

●DEANNA MOORE, a Stardust Drive resident, is also in the tenth grade. Regarding smoking, she remarked, "I don't think they should do it at school, or anywhere else. Teenagers should get rid of that bad habit."

●SONEL MARTIS BENNERMAN lives on Burbank Drive and is a junior at West Charlotte. His opinion was less definite than some of the others. About a no-smoking rule, he commented, "I think it's all right to a certain extent. Some who smoke don't affect the school system. But if a teenager abuses smoking, I'm for the rule."

●JULIE WATERS, also in the eleventh grade, resides on Standish Place. She liked the proposed changes in the smoking rules. "I think it's nice because certain students' smoke bothers me. Smoking also litters up the school and makes the school look bad."

●JON MORRIS of McDonald Street is another junior. "I think it's a good rule to have," he asserted. Admitting that he himself is a non-smoker, he stated, "Other students should respect the rights of students who don't smoke."

●MALIKA WILLIAMS, Yuma resident, is a senior. She wasn't sure about the wisdom of the proposed change. Although a non-smoker herself, Ms. Williams declared, "If they're going to enforce it, it's not good, because some students will smoke anyway. It's better the way it is now, because students don't have to sneak."
