She remarked on the need for parents, teachers, and other adults who work with children to recognize the value of childhood and to reflect on how well the needs of children are being met. Besides CMAEYC and the School System, other cooperating agencies and organizations include the Council for Children, Child Care Resources, Inc., Charlotte Public Library, Community School of the Arts, Nature Museum, CPCC, John-


