was that our preachers don't know what it means to be a lost sinner. Also, I asked him what he knew about a hard heart of unbelief. He knew nothing about what I was talking about

He, also, invited me down to his church. The next day I wrote him a note and told him; "I noted that your people have a great zeal but not according to knowledge." The word "zeal" means; eager desire or effort, or earnest enthusiasm. While there in his church people were shouting "Amens" before he could get the words out. Many were waving their hands in approval and you couldn't hear the preacher sometimes because the folks were drowning him out with their responses. All that is just wildfire religion. The preacher could have been cursing them and they wouldn't know it. That wildfire religion is spreading across the country and around the world as never before.
