Williette Robertson To Participate In "Miss Teen" Finals

Former Charlotte Post Beauty of the Week, Williette Robertson, has been selected to participate in the Modern Miss Teen Scholarship State Finals, to be held in Charlotte at the Adam's Mark Hotel in November.

Robertson is the daughter of Melvina Robertson and at 17 years of age she is multi-talented and a high scholastic achiever

Presently a senior at Myers Park School, Robertson participated, this summer, in East Carolina University's Summer Ventures Program in science and math. Her studies were in Twentieth Century Physics, Matrix Algebra with computer applications and Number's Theory Form. Robertson also presented a seminar entitled. "Number Theory with Primek Numbers," during the Ventures program.

An experienced dancer, Robertson has danced with the Dance Connections at Spirit Square and on the last day of the Summer Ventures Program she coreographed a modern dance routine and presented it at the program's talent show.

Other involvements for Robertson include participation in the Youth Involvement Council; Junior Achievement; Youth Advisor Council: Latin Club and Honor Society; the American Red Cross; the Children's Theatre; and Upward Bound; and she was included in Who's Who among High School Students.

Throughout the year. the National Modern Miss Scholarship Program will award over \$600,000 in scholarships and tuition grants to many outstanding teenagers in competition.

Post Office Serious **About Dog Bites**

The confrontation between dog and letter carrier has become almost classic humor. Is it really funny? The Charlotte Post Office pesn't think so, and neither should

yone in this community. Last year, almost 6,000 of this nation's letter carriers were bitten by dogs. Many of the injuries were , and some of the victims suffered permanent disfigurement. The cost to the Postal Service and og owners who subsequently paid out injury costs and punitive damages in many dog bite cases exceeded \$2 million. Many more dolars and injuries can be counted among non-postal workers and individuals who were also bitten by

The common assertion that "He lossn't bite" is not supported by the ainful statistics. Any dog will bite if t feels it is protecting its territory or

The simple solution to this pro-lem is for pet owners to recog-ize their responsibility to keep their logs restrained by a fense or se-ure leash or tether. leash or teth

Dog owners who do not restrain heir pets are risking lawsuits and nterruption of home mail delivery. The Postal Service will seek to re-cover damages when a carrier is oitten, and counsels its bitten carbitten, and counsels its bitten carriers wishing to sue on their own.
The Postal Service will also interrupt mail delivery where loose dogs
are a problem – including, in extreme cases, interruption of delivery
to entire neighborhoods.

These remedies need not occur if
Charlotte residents do their part to
reduce dog bite injuries by keeping
their pais properly restrained.


