**Senator Mel Watt
Appointed To State
Commissions**

Lieutenant Governor Bob Jordan has appointed Mel Watt (D-Meck.) to the Housing Trust Fund Study Commission and the Enterprise-Zone Venture Capital Study Commission.

"Senator Watt has done an outstanding job during his first term in the Senate. I appreciate his willingness to take on these additional responsibilities. His legal expertise will be valuable to these groups as they deliberate the issues before them," Lt. Governor Jordan said.

The Housing Trust Fund Study Commission will examine the need for low income housing in the state and investigate the feasibility of establishing a North Carolina Housing Trust Fund. The Enterprise-Zone Venture Capital Study Commission will examine the establishment of a system of enterprise zones in the state and study ways to attract venture capital to the state.

Teacher Shortage

Alarmed at the increasing shortage of black teacher applicants, the Beaufort, South Carolina Board of Education has passed a resolution calling on state and local officials and all citizens to take positive steps which will result in making the teaching profession more attractive.

Board member York Glover, author of the resolution, feels that more effort must be made at all levels to attract and maintain a higher percentage of black teachers in our schools. Acknowledging the fact that attractive opportunities are available in business and industry does not alleviate the necessity to maintain minority role models in our public schools.

The Beaufort County Board of Education is committed to raising the standards of the teaching profession and strongly urges agencies, organizations, and citizens to support efforts to make the teaching profession competitive with private industry.
