Anheuser-Busch Promotes Johnson To Area Manager

Atlanta, Ga. - Anheuser-Busch, Inc., the world's largest brewer, has announced the promotion of Dinia Johnson as area sales manager in Georgia and parts of Mississippi. The announcement was made by James I. Hunter III, region sales manager for Anheuser-Busch, Inc., in the Southeast.

Johnson previously served as area sales manager for four years in North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee.

Her promotion to the company's Atlanta division office places her in critical major markets where she will be responsible for coordinating sales and marketing management for Anheuser-Busch beer products and for community relations programs. The Atlanta division office is headed by Robert J. Walsdorf, division manager. Anheuser-Busch is the brewer of Budweiser, Bud Light, Michelob, Michelob Light, Natural Light, Busch and King Cobra Premium Malt Liqueur.

Johnson began her career with the company in 1979 as a project marketing team member in Dallas. She then moved on to serve as project marketing team supervisor in Houston, Chicago, and Detroit.

As area sales manager in the Carolinas and Tennessee, Johnson supervised the test marketing of the company's malt liquor beverage in five cities.

She spearheaded the creation of Bustin' Budds Suds, a grassroots marketing program which began in Chattanooga, Tenn., with Beasley Distributing and became one of the company's key national sales promotion programs.

She was voted the most outstanding area sales manager for the Southeast for two years, receiving the coveted Anheuser-Busch Accent on Excellence Award.

She has also received a number of other awards for her community involvement activities. This includes national awards such as the 1983 Outstanding Young Women of America Award, and in 1981 she received the New York YMCA Blacks In Industry Award.

Johnson is a member of two major national black women's organizations, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority and The Drifters.

A twin, she was born in Longview, Texas, and raised in Dallas. She will reside in Atlanta.
