

Campaign In High Gear As November 5 Fast Approaches

With the general election less than two weeks away, campaigning by local candidates remains in high gear. Races include City Council at-large seats, with eight candidates competing for four seats; City Council district 4, Roy Matthews (D) vs. Jim Hawks (R); and, of course, the mayoral contest between Republican Dave Berryhill and Democratic incumbent Harvey Gantt.

Gantt and Berryhill squared off in a televised debate on WBTB on Sunday; they'll do so again on WSOC-TV on November 3.

Also appearing on the ballot will be a series of bond issues for such amenities as water, sewer, schools, pools, and other needed or wanted facilities. Details on the bonds appear in other stories in this week's Post.

GANTT FUNDRAISER

The Gantt Campaign will hold a caravan through City Council Districts 1, 2, and 3 on Saturday, October 26. The caravan will depart from Mayor Harvey Gantt's home, 517 N. Mayor Harvey Gantt, who is seeking reelection, will campaign with the caravan. Other elected officials will also travel with the caravan.

ENDORSEMENTS
The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Black Political Caucus, chaired by James K. Polk, has made the following endorsements for the upcoming election: Mayor, Harvey Gantt; City Council at-large, Cyndee Patterson, Minette Troesch, Richard Vinroot, Mike Stenhouse; City Council District 4, Roy Matthews; Districts 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7, the unopposed candidates; school board, Harvey Sadoff. (District 6 candidate, Velva Woolen, was not endorsed because of lack of information.) Passage of all bonds was also endorsed, but no recommendation was made on increasing County Commission terms to four years.
