The project contemplated consists of providing 12,700 fine bubble diffusers for aerating wastewater.

Bidders wishing to have their equipment considered are required to submit the Equipment Information Submittal specified herein, with the Bid.

Bid Bond shall be retained if successful bidder fails to execute the contract within ten (10) days after award.
