## Shakespeare Festival Opens '87 Season

Tickets are now available for the 1987 season of The North Carolina Shakespeare Festival. Performances of William Shakespeare's **Richard II**, **A Midsummer Night's Dream**, **Romeo and Juliet** and Thornton Wilder's **Our Town** will be presented at High Point Theatre, Stevens Center in Winston-Salem and Aycock Auditorium in Greensboro between July 23 and September 13. **Richard II** (July 23), **A Midsummer Dream** (July 30) and **Our Town** (August 6) will open and run in repertory at High Point Theatre through August 29. **Romeo and Juliet** (September 3) will be presented

exclusively at Stevens Center between September 3 and 10. **A Midsummer Night's Dream** will conclude the regular season with two additional performances at Aycock Auditorium on September 12 and 13.

A Southeastern tour of **A Midsummer Night's Dream** will immediately follow the season and conclude on November 8. **A Midsummer Night's Dream** is presented through the sponsorship of NCNB of North Carolina. The High Point Convention and Visitors Bureau is sponsoring presentation of **Our Town**. **Romeo and Juliet** is presented through the sponsorship of
