

Seminar To Help Develop Skills In Textiles

The second annual Master Textile and Sewing Craftsmen Seminar will begin September 24th at the Mecklenburg County Home Economics Extension Department. The ten, 3-hour, sessions will emphasize advanced and professional technology in textiles, sewing design and marketing.

The purpose of the seminar is to provide training for professional and technical leaders who will return equal hours to Extension in teaching clientele from beginners to advanced clothing and household linens, in selection, buymanship, construction, care, storage and fashions.

Extension Service is dedicated to

meeting the educational needs of all the people within the area of Textiles and Sewing. The Master's Program is a vehicle designed to help reach this goal. Persons interested in participating in the Master's Program should call 336-2692 for an application.

"We are striving to facilitate educational means that will help citizens, especially young adults, in developing skills that will enable them to produce clothing, alterations and household textile furnishings at home; thereby stretching this area so that monies saved may be used for other area needs. Social Studies and other subjects have become so competitive in the school

system, as well as demands for time and space in the curriculum by other subject disciplines, that training in Home Economics has often been pushed aside and even off the schedule.

Therefore, Extension Home Economics seeks to bridge that gap. The Master Textile and Sewing Craftsmen are reaching out with long stretched arms to scores, even hundreds, of people who would not, through ordinary means, be able to receive the instruction necessary."

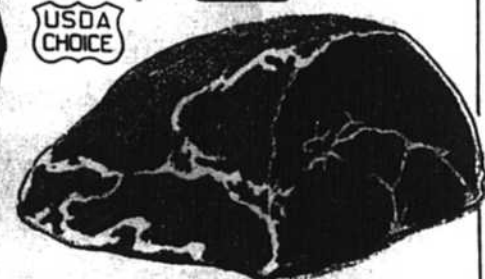
