Panelists include WPCQ's morning news anchor Beatrice Thompson; WBT's "Top o' The Day" co-host Lynne Bradley-Love, WSCOTV's weekend news anchor Suzanne Stevens and WCCB's Public Affairs Director Charlene Price.

Other speakers and their topics include Lily Sang, human services specialist, "Women Helping Women in Crisis and Transition;" Laura McClettle, entrepreneur, "Self-Image and Networking;" and Linda Combs-Shepherd, psychotherapist, "Self-Image and the Female Spirit."
