

Harlem Art Is Going To Tennessee

The highly acclaimed Exhibition, "Harlem Renaissance, The Art of Black America," opens at Cheekwood's Fine Arts Center in Nashville, Tennessee, June 17 and remains until August 6.

The Studio Museum in Harlem has assembled a core of over 100 works by a small but representative group of artists -- sculptor Meta Warrick Fuller, painters Aaron Douglas, Palmer Hayden, and William H. Johnson, and photographer James Van Der Zee -- in order to take an in-depth look at some of the most compelling images by artists whose work first came to prominence in Harlem during the 1920s.

The decade of the 20s, also known as the Jazz Age, was a time that black artists, musicians, politicians and entrepreneurs converged on Harlem and created what is known as the Harlem Renaissance. It was a time, as one resident recently described, when "it was truly bliss to be alive." Not only did blacks take pride in their African heritage, pride in black folklore, pride in just being black, but it also seemed natural to believe that art could bridge the formidable gap between the black and white worlds, that excellence and merit could produce social change.

John Russell, art critic of the New York Times, said, when the exhibition opened at the studio Museum in Harlem, "No one interested in the social and aesthetic history of America should miss it."

The Fine Arts Center will present a full program of special events to complement the exhibition, including a four-day symposium with scholars speaking on all the cultural aspects of the Harlem Renaissance.

sance. There will also be a number of musical programs featuring the music of the Jazz Age.

The exhibition was organized by the Studio Museum in Harlem with support from the National

Endowment for the Arts, the National Endowment for the Humanities, and Philip Morris Companies, Inc., and is circulated under the auspices of the Art Museum Association of America.
