The lily white makeup of the boards of directors goes a long way toward explaining the racial disparity in employment and lending practices by these insti-tutions," said Meredith Emmett, executive director of the Institute. "The same good ol' boy net-work that excludes blacks, His-panics, and women from their policy-making circles also ig-pores outreach programs that would attract minority home buyers.

Earlier this year, the Atlanta Journal-Constitution published an analysis of home loans made by the nation's S&L industry between 1983 and 1988. It showed that blacks were rejected for mortgage loans at more than wice the rate of whites (a 23.7 percent rejection rate versus [1.1 percent). In nine of the 13 states surveyed by the Institute, the top 10 savings and loans hold over 60 percent of the as-sets - including home loans - of the state's entire S&L industry. "These institutions are asking the public for billions of dollars

for the largest bailout in Ameri-can history," said Emmett. "The public has every right to ask how well they have been serving their communities. What would taxpayers get in return for paying the \$1,000 a piece that Bush wants for his bailout plan?

"Unfortunately, the evidence shows that S&Ls have been insensitive to the needs of the people on their neighborhoods," she added. 'They have failed to implement the kinds of affirmative action remedies needed to correct years of conscious and unconscious racial bias.

"Without changes at the top, we can't realistically expect changes in behavior at the neighborhood level - in lending and employment practices," Em-mett concluded. "And without greater public accountability, we shouldn't continue providing government-backed insurance for their depositors or pay a nickel to bail out those now in trouble, let alone the \$1,000 Bush wants.


improved," he said, "but it hasn't." Madans accused Myrick of be-
