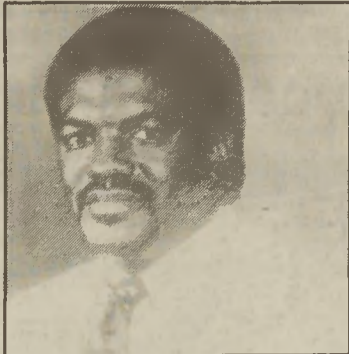
The Hymn Choir of Pleasant Hill Baptist Church will observe its anniversary on Sunday, April 23 at 5 p.m.

At 2:30 the Senior Choir will celebrate its 42nd anniversary with other guest choirs and choruses.

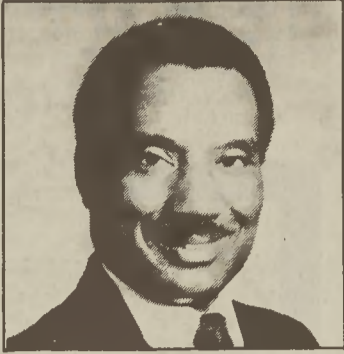

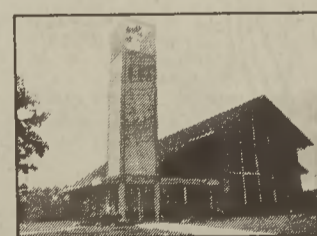
