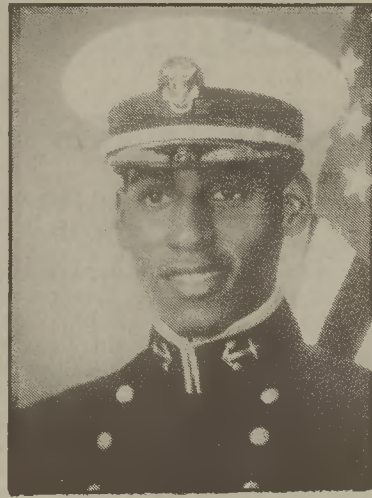
While at the academy, Edwards achieved the status of Second Regimental Commander. He was responsible for leading half the brigade of midshipmen. He is president of the Midshipmen's

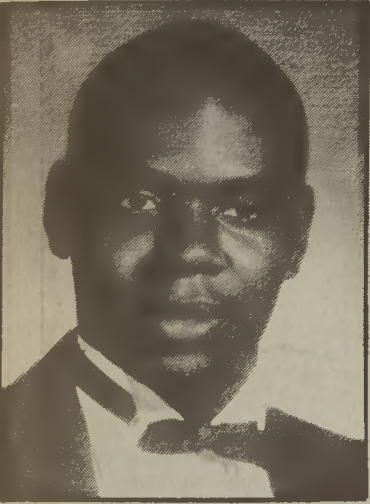

During his last semester at NCCU, Heath received job offers from two Fortune 500 companies.

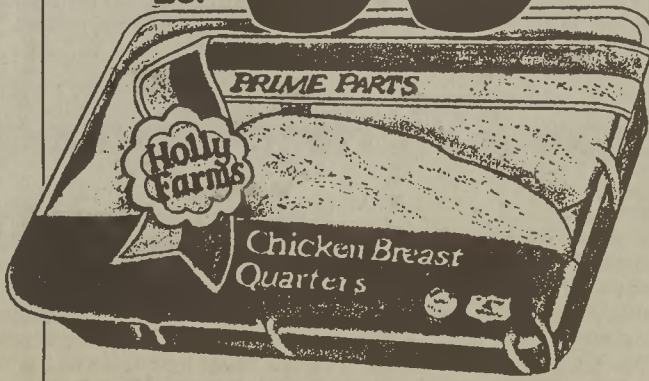
