### PLEASANT HILL

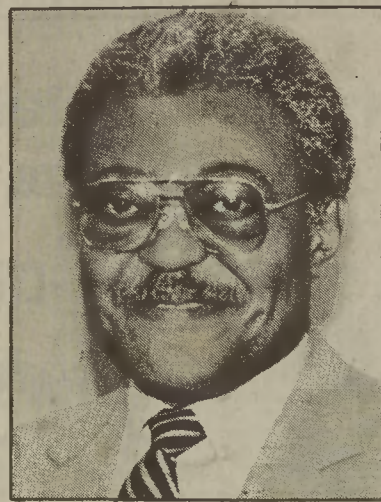

Rev. A. L. Jinwright, pastor of Salem Baptist Church will be the guest speaker.

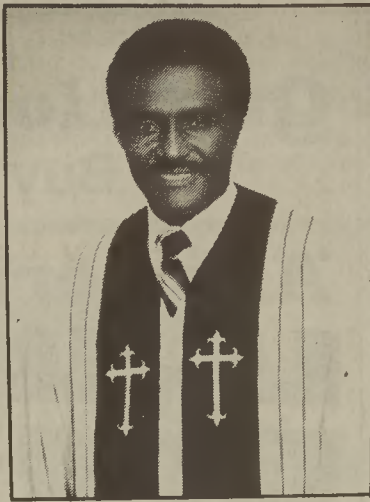

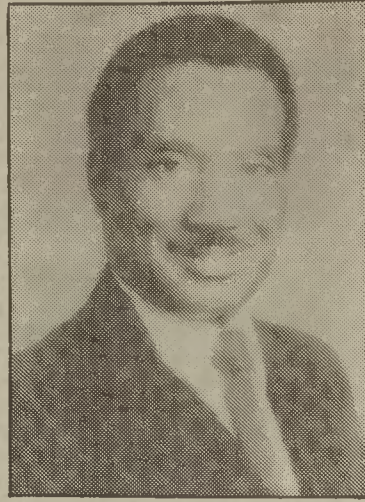

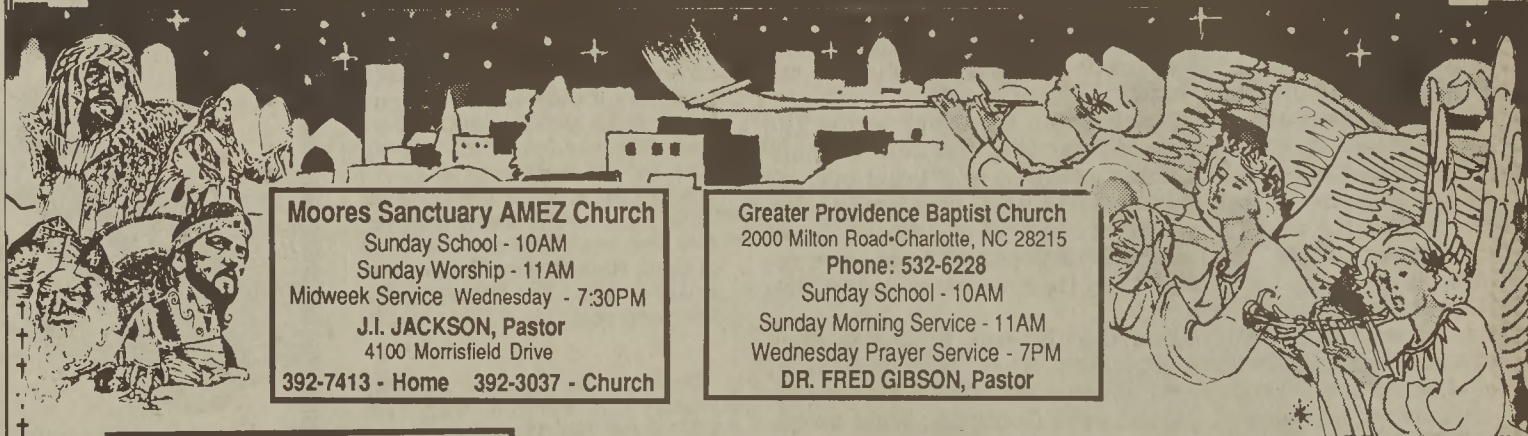
### SPIRITUAL WARFARE

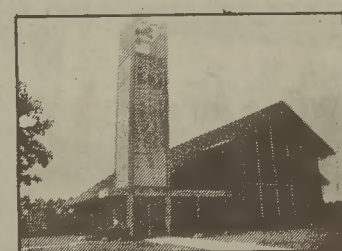
