## Batman Features Talents Of Billy Dee Williams And Prince

When "Batman" spreads his wings from coast-to-coast at over 2,000 theatres on June 23rd, two fabulous talents will be making their own special contributions to the eagerly awaited action adventure film from Warner Bros. and the Guber-Peters Company. Starring with Jack Nicholson, Michael Keaton and Kim Basinger in the motion picture is the extraordinarily versatile stage, screen and television actor Billy Dee Williams...and contributing songs to the musical soundtrack is one of the rock world's most celebrated and controversial superstars, Prince.

In "Batman," Williams plays Harvey Dent, a smart, sharp-suited lawyer running for district attorney of Gotham City on a law-and-order ticket. Respected for his meticulous preparation for every character he portrays, Williams hit upon a very appropriate role model for

Harvey Dent. "The image I used," he explains, "was Adam Clayton Powell. He was a wonderfully appealing politician from Harlem back in the 1940s, '50s and '60s. Powell was constantly in the news, very flamboyant, a hero to many people."

Williams, perhaps best known to his fans as the dashing Lando Calrissian in "The Empire Strikes Back" and "Return of the Jedi," continues to demonstrate his considerable skills in new and adventurous endeavors. He

recently starred on Broadway in August Wilson's Tony Award-winning drama "Fences," and television viewers know him as music mogul Brad Lloyd on "Dynasty."

Prince has written nine songs inspired by "Batman," some of which will be included in the actual film. A special album of his "Batman" music will be available in stores on June 20, and "Batdance"--Prince's first single from the album--will be available sooner.
