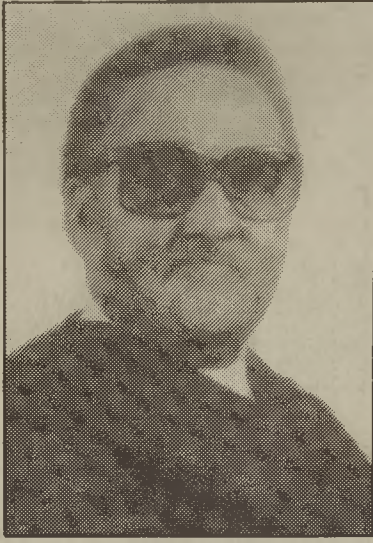
At 6 p.m. the 1988 Mayfield Man of the Year, Bobbie Shields, will deliver the closing message.

The public is invited to attend. The church is located at 700 Sugar Creek Road. Dr. H. S. Diggs is the pastor.

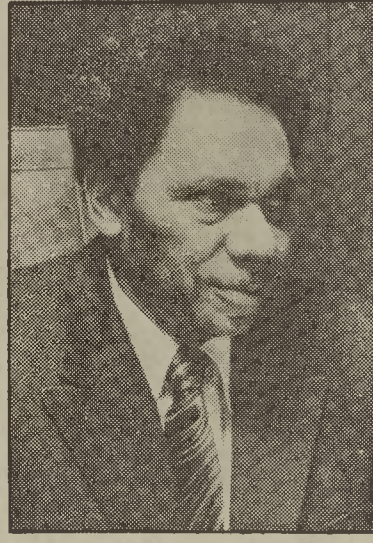

The guest speaker will be Ruth Yvonne Stowe of Silver Mount Primitive Baptist Church in Concord.

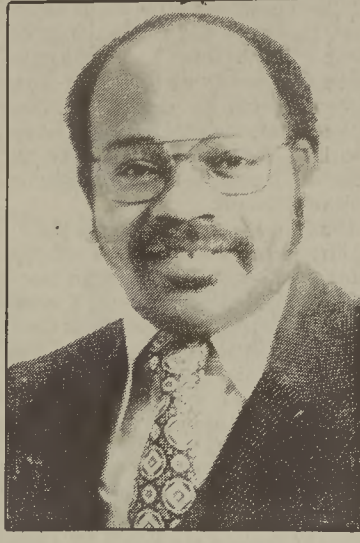

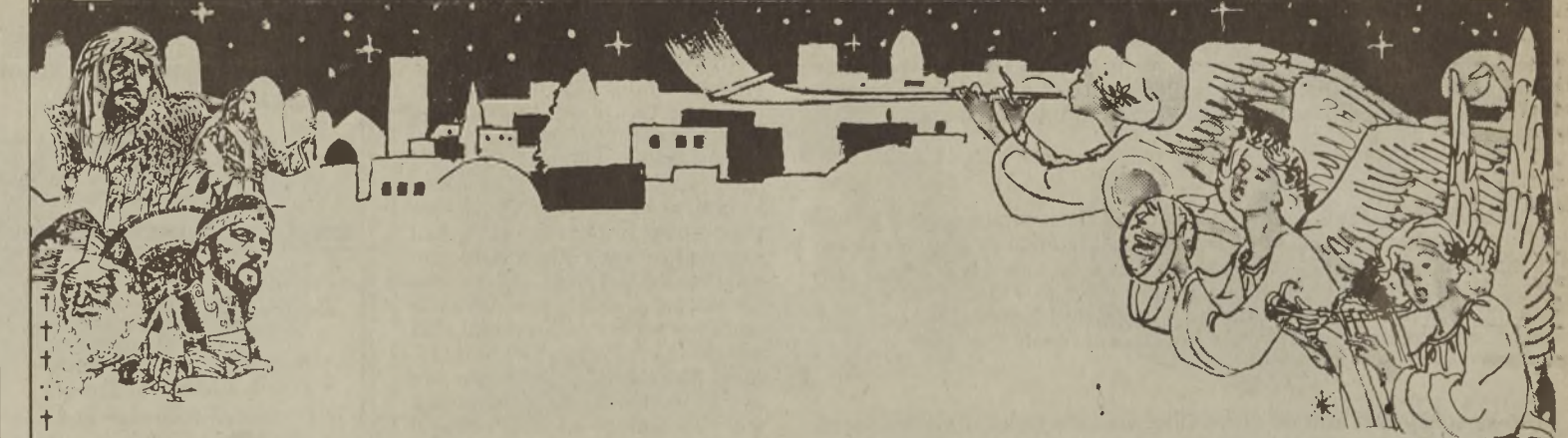
