Pleasant Hill Baptist Church will observe its annual revival the week of August 7th-11th. Services will begin at 7:30 nightly.

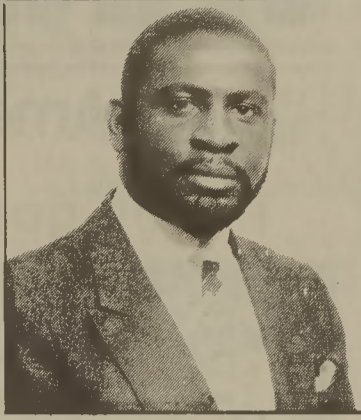
Rev. E. R. Millsaps pastor of New Hope Baptist Church will be the evangelist for the week.

The public is invited to attend. The church is located at 517 Baldwin Avenue. Rev. J. A. Cuthbertson is the pastor.

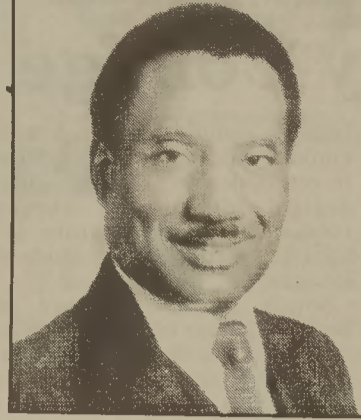
